11. Container on Eccles Recreation Ground – The Assistant Clerk has asked the resident a series of questions through Councillor Ludlow and will report to members at the meeting.

12. Entrance to Podkin Meadow – Councillor Smith reported at the March meeting of this committee that the Mill Lane/Warren Road entrance to Podkin Meadow was very muddy. The Maintenance Supervisor has looked and recommended that Type 1 or similar could be put down. A quote for £562.00 has been obtained. The Assistant Clerk and Councillor Smith will report at the meeting.

13. Forstal Road Recreation Ground Tennis Court – Metal Net – The metal net is broken and needs replacing. A quote has been obtained for £480.00. Member’s decision is required.

14. Forstal Road Recreation Ground – Cross Rider – The Footplate has a hole in it and needs replacing. This is through general wear and tear. A quote has been obtained from the manufacturer Caloo for £690.00 including parts, labour and fitting. Member’s instruction is required.

15. Access Road to Rugby Club - Pot Holes – Assistant Clerk to report at meeting.

16. Ferryfield – Grass Cutting – Possible closure of gates due to increasing Health & Safety issues when the Maintenance Supervisor is cutting the grass in the car park area. Member’s instruction is required.
