The Clerk reported that the Council had spent only £1429.81 more than it had received in income despite having spent £77,000 from its earmarked reserves on projects such as the completion of the conversion of street lights to LED project, RBLI Base Camp play area donation and purchase of a new mower. This therefore left the reserves only slightly reduced to just under £249,000.

The Clerk will be reporting to the Policy & Resources Committee in June on the allocation of the funds in reserves.
