4. Planning Applications

4.1 24/01824 – Land South of London Road and East of Hermitage Lane, Aylesford South

Details of Phase 2 Affordable Housing Scheme (schedule 1, paragraph 2.1) submitted pursuant to S106 Agreement on Outline planning permission TM/17/01595/OAEA (Outline Application for erection of up to 840 dwellings (including affordable homes) with public open space, landscaping, sustainable drainage systems, land for a Primary School, doctors surgery and for junction improvements at Hermitage Lane/A20 junction, and a link road between Poppy Fields roundabout and Hermitage Lane. Vehicular access into the site from Poppy Fields Roundabout and Hermitage Lane. All matters reserved with the exception of means of access)
