1. Apologies for Absence

3. Minutes of the last meeting held on Tuesday 16th June 2026

It was **Resolved** that the Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 16th June 2026 be approved as a correct record and signed.

4. Planning Applications

4.1 TM/26/00768/TPOC 26 Oaks Dene, Walderslade

1 x Cherry Plum (*Prunus Cerasifera*) -Fell. Trees 2 and 3 Hornbeam -Fell. The trees are restricting natural sunlight into our home and garden; they are creating an abundance of leaves and foliage. Trees standing in W6 of TPO

It was **Agreed** the Cherry should be felled but the Hornbeam should be pruned – the Tree Officer should visit the site to inspect as there didn't seem to be much information on the Planning Portal about it.

Details of condition 33 (Written Scheme of Investigation) pursuant to planning permission TM/22/00113/OAEA Residential development of up to 950 dwellings, provision of a mixed-use local centre (including Class E, F and C3 with potential for retirement homes) provision of land to accommodate a new primary school, replacement sports pitches with changing facilities; associated green infrastructure including landscaping, public open space, allotments, sustainable urban drainage systems, biodiversity enhancements; new accesses from Bull Lane; new access and road/cycleway/footpath link to New Court Road

To amend condition 2 (Approved plans) to reflect a series of minor amendments proposed to the approved development

4.7 TM/26/01030/RD Cobdown Sports Ground Station Road, Ditton

Redevelopment of existing Clubhouse building, refurbishment of existing Academy building; demolition of ancillary buildings and structures across the Site; provision of new grounds maintenance building and service area; refurbishment of existing pavilion building to provide upgraded changing and kitchen facilities; provision of new upgraded grass football pitches and upgrade of existing synthetic surface; new areas for car and cycle parking; upgrade to existing sports lighting; boundary treatment and hard and soft landscaping and associated site infrastructure and site plant
