4. Planning Applications

4.1 TM/22/02679/TPOC - 1 Frensham Walk Chatham, Walderslade

Sisal Oak- 1] Reduce height of tree to last reduction height. 2] Remove branches below the gutter level of the dwelling house. 3] Cut out and remove dead wood. 4] Reduce the spread of the tree over neighbouring properties back to boundary fence of No 3 Frensham Walk and to a spread deemed acceptable to the authority in respect of 8 Marlow Copse removing growth in excess of 6.5m. Standing in group W7 of Tree Preservation Order

4.2 TM/22/02836/FL - 6 Mill Lane Blue Bell Hill

Change of use from class C3 (residential) to class C2 (Residential institutions) for children services

It was **Agreed** to raise **No Objection**

4.3 TM/22/02701/AT - 14 Wood Close Quarry Wood Industrial Estate Aylesford

Relocation of previously approved Kinto sign (TM/22/01955/AT, sign E)

It was **Agreed** to raise **No Objection**

4.4 TM/22/02878/FL- Land South and East of Overflow Parking Hermitage Court Hermitage Lane

Stationing of 4 MRI/CT Scanners and associated structures and provision of hardstanding and parking

It was Agreed to raise No Objection

4.5 TM/23/00003/TNCA - Church Barn 88 High Street Aylesford North

Sycamore Tree T1 (applicant ref) - fell and remove. Due to the proximity of to the ancient wall as well as uplifting the public footpath and being a trip hazard. Stump to be ground out. Sycamore Tree T2 (applicants ref) – remove all new growth back to stump. Poison stump using eco-plugs to prevent regrowth as it has caused damage to the footpath.

T1; It was **Agreed** to raise - **An Objection -** T1 is on the Public Footpath MR472. It is a mature tree which should be retained for its Landscape and environmental value. The roots are acceptable in a rural path.

T2; It was **Agreed** to raise **- No Objection** to the removal of this multi-stemmed tree. It is damaging the historic cast-iron fence (matching that round the Churchyard) which should be repaired.

5. KCC – Hermitage Lane

Proposed junction alterations and installation of new island to prevent right turning in and out of the junction for the Croudace Development.

It was **Agreed** to raise an **Objection**

6. Any Other Correspondence

The Clerk reported that correspondence had been received from National Highways Lower
Thames Crossing as the legislation requires them to make an application to the Planning
Inspectorate for a Development Consent Order to get the consent needed to build the project.
