AYLESFORD, ECCLES, BLUEBELL HILL, WALDERSLADE February 22

Theft- Curry's,- Aylesford. 4males stole around 20 laptops from the store estimated at £1000- £1300. CCTV Available.

Attempt theft- Sainsburys, Aylesford. A male in a white Ford transit was seen near the store trying to steal clothes from the bin nearby.

Theft-Marks and Spencer, Aylesford. A mother and daughter went to the store to buy some food and they left a handbag on their car seat. When they returned minutes later the car had been broken into and handbag was missing.

Attempt theft- Aylesford train station. 3 males were seen trying to steal a motorbike which was padlocked. They managed to start the bike but left when they saw a vehicle pull up beside them.

Theft- Sainsburys, Aylesford. A female worker alerted police when her driving card and two bank cards were stolen. Her handbag was hanging in the staff room at the time.

Criminal damage- A20, Aylesford. A female was driving home along the A20 towards West Malling when she heard a loud bang. Someone had thrown an object at her windscreen causing it to shatter. Possible CCTV nearby.

Shoplifting- Aldi, Hermitage lane, Aylesford. A female entered the store and stole a mirror and bedding worth £50. CCTV nearby.
