Aylesford-Eccles-Bluebell Hill-Walderslade SEPTEMBER 22

Aylesford quarry- Youths were trespassing on a steel boat. There was cause for concern and kfrs attended but the youths had already left. Youths were 12-15 years old.

Criminal damage-catherine howard close, Aylesford. A female woke in the early hours of the morning to find someone banging on her window. They then threw an object causing the window to smash. The resident believes she knows the male.

Theft-Tottingdon House, Thomas road, Aylesford. A resident was expecting a parcel from Amazon, but said it did not arrive. She contacted Amazon and they confirmed it was delivered and would not give her a refund. The parcel was stolen from her front door step.

Adventure kidz, Quarrywood, Aylesford. A female dropped her kids off to the play centre and then went outside to smoke drugs. CCTV captured the incident and the centre had all details.

Fraud- Sainsburys, Quarrywood, Aylesford. An elderly gentleman with parkinsons disease was stopped by a female in Sainsburys claiming that she had broken down in the car park and needed £40 to pay the mechanic. Later it

Mcdonalds, Aylesford. A young male went into buy some food and accidentally dropped a knife which he picked up and put back in his pocket. Staff alerted police with descriptions.

Criminal damage-Arden BMW, Aylesford. A customers car on the forecourt was keyed and it is believed that a male and female were in the area earlier acting suspicious.
